Treasurer's Report was given by M. Senzig: End of March checking account balance was \$154,705.78. Bank of Mauston CD balance was \$100,000.00 Motion by D. Franek to enter the treasurer's report into the official minutes; second by J. Masch; carried by a voice vote of 3 ayes.

Clerk's Report J.L. Masch reported that Trash and Recycling will not be picked on Monday, May 26, 2025 it will be Tuesday, May 27, 2025. The website for Republic Services has the calendar wrong for our area.

Ambulance Report B.D. Hawkins all they have 1 position open and 4-5 people in training. They are looking for a new mass casualty trailer for Mauston/Elroy as the one now has a leak in the roof. The end of month balance was \$879,303.14. April Total calls 291 with 15 in Kildare and 12 transfers. No meeting in May next meeting will be the last Monday of June.

Supervisor's Report. B.D. Hawkins reported that the survey for the property across the street has been surveyed, if you go by the orange flags are up. They met with Jim Morris to talk about the new Town Hall. We will be looking at flooring, siding and roofing. Voting for the new Town Hall will be in June, please come to let us know what you think.
